

## Deities Poster Project

Using the name you chose in class, gather information about your deity by listening to the DVD we are watching in class and reading the articles. You will be working on a poster in class. Things to put on your poster include the following:

1. Greek and Roman Name
2. What the deity is known for (Athena is associated with wisdom, warriors, etc.)
3. An image of the god/goddess properly attired for a classroom presentation
4. Images of objects (or animals) often associated with that particular god/goddess
5. Bullet points with information about your deity
  - a. Make sure the print is large enough to be read from a distance.

### Rubric for Content Portion of Poster:

(50-45) A

- Content provides enough description and is accurate.
- Very few writing convention errors.
- Titles, description and picture are neatly written, placed and cut.
- Color and creativity make the poster attractive and interesting.

(44-40) B

- Content mostly provides enough description and is mostly accurate.
- A few writing convention errors.
- Titles, description and picture are mostly neatly written, placed and cut.
- Color and creativity mostly make the poster attractive and interesting.

(39-35) C

- Content somewhat provides enough description and is somewhat accurate.
- Some writing convention errors.
- Titles, description and picture are somewhat neatly written, placed and cut.
- Color and creativity somewhat make the poster attractive and interesting.

(34-30) D

- Content does not provide enough description and is not accurate.
- Many writing convention errors.
- Titles, description and picture are not neatly written, placed and cut.
- Color and creativity do not make the poster attractive or interesting.
