Parts Joined by And

A compound subject whose parts are joined by and usually requires a plural verb.

Michael Jackson and the Eagles have sold over 22 million copies of single albums.

Rhythm and blues is a music style developed in the South.

consists of singular parts modified by each, every, or many a
Almost every teenager and young adult has been influenced by the music of Elvis Presley.

Parts Joined by Or or Nor

When the parts of a compound subject are joined by or or nor, the verb should agree with the part closest to it.



Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart or Johann Sebastian Bach is often named as the greatest composer of classical music.



Neither Mozart nor the five Bachs have left as much music as Georg Philipp Telemann, however.
